In 2016, the RULH MCJROTC program was awarded the Reginal School of Distinction. As a District that continues to participate in the Ohio Improvement Process, it has actively involved DLT's, BLT's and TBT's across all three buildings, and has a 4 year graduation rate of 92.5%
