(+\$14,500) - Remove concrete sidewalk and replace with PIP surface (+\$10,538) These revisions would make the total estimate \$261.656.95. To that total will need to be added the cost of moving the Catherine Street Fence in to revised playground perimeter, and installing a new fence, walk-in gate, and service

gate. Mr. Rowley the Treasure had not yet received a quote on this portion of the project, but estimate it to be as much as \$13,000 based on the linear feet, and how much of the old fence could be repurposed.

Mr. Rowley said that would make the total cost of the project with all recommend additions and fencing at \$274,656.95.

Mr. Rowley noted that would mean the financed would have to be as follows:

- > Permanent Improvement Levy Funds \$201,789
- > General Operating Funds \$72,867.95

Mr. Rowley noted that if the board recalled from his 5 year forecast presentation last month, that he had included a Capital Outlay amount of \$75,000 for next school year to cover this anticipated project run over.
